NEU STRIKE WEDNESDAY, 15TH AND THURSDAY, 16TH MARCH 2023

I hope this email finds you and your family healthy and well.

I am sorry to be writing to you again about teacher strike days that are affecting us being open for all children on Wednesday, 15th and Thursday, 16th March 2023

The teacher strikes are happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over funding for schools and teachers' pay, and not because of any issues here at Hadley.

Unfortunately, we will not be able to have all children in school as we will have less teachers in site than we usually do. I want to ensure the children and safe and well cared for.
