<p>Science</p> 	<p>We will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning about growing a healthy lifestyle • Understand the basic needs for human and animal survival. • Understand all animals produce offspring through eggs or live young • Understand the life cycle of human development and common milestones within each stage • Understand the importance of exercise on growth, repair and development • Understand the importance of a healthy, balanced diet on growth, repair and development

- Making a repeated printed pattern.
- To print with sponges, vegetables and fruit onto paper and textile.
