We will be using our geographical knowledge to locate India, Pakistan and Bangladesh and its surrounding states. The children will be learning facts on these three countries and how they have changed over time.

<p>Science</p> 	<p>We will be</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning about the human Skeleton • Learning about different muscles in the body • Learning about the importance of bones and muscles in different parts of the body. • Exploring how nutrition supports the development of muscle and bone.
<p>Art</p> 	<p>We will be</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning to draw and sketch using different mediums • We will be creating a silhouette puppet/portrait • We will be researching silhouette artists
