Welcome back to school! We have many exciting things planned this term, with lots of learning about 'Planet Enfield' in Topic. We will be starting our fantastic text "*Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*" by Roald Dahl, which we will be studying in both our Guided Reading and Writing lessons.

<p>English</p> 	<p>We will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Writing narratives • Using expanded noun phrases and prepositional phrases • Using apostrophes for possession and contraction • Writing poems in the correct layout
<p>Mathematics</p> 	<p>We will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exploring different addition and subtraction strategies • Practicing short multiplication and short division • Problem solving using four operations • Reading, interpreting, and comparing pictograms and charts
<p>Science</p> 	<p>We will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Working scientifically to carrying out tests to answer questions. • Understanding the function of teeth • Exploring the digestive system
<p>Art</p> 	<p>We will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Planning and creating a 3D sculpture using recycled pieces of material
<p>Geography</p> 	<p>We will be</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Using four and six figure grid references, symbols, and keys to read a map. • Describing settlement and land use of Enfield. • Exploring the changes around Enfield over time. • Describing the distribution of natural resources, including energy within Enfield.
<p>Music</p> 	<p>We will be</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exploring compositions and perform poems from around the world .

<p>P.E</p> 	<p>We will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Developing a broader range of techniques and skills e.g. forward drive, defence, pull, cut etc. • Choosing and applying skills more consistently in all games. • Identifying the best tactics needed to suit the game. • Analysing performances in order to apply a professionally approach. • Identifying importance of physical activity in order to talk confidently about why.
<p>Computing</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The children will be using their iPads to create stop motion animation.
<p>R.E</p> 	<p>We will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Studying Islam • Learning how Muslim people worship and honour Allah in their daily lives • Exploring the Five Pillars of Islam and their meaning
<p>P.S.H.E and Citizenship</p> 	<p>We will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Developing Emotional Health and Listening.

Here are some ways that you can help your child at home:

- It is very important that you read with your child for 20 minutes every night - please remember to do so and don't forget to sign your child's reading record!
- Support your child to complete their homework and hand it in on time on the iPad Help your child learn their multiplication tables by regularly practising with them at home, in the car or in any spare time you may have.
- Practise your child's spelling with them to prepare them for their weekly test, remembering their handwriting joins.
- Encourage your child to check their spellings in their writing – every bit helps!
- Please ensure that your child brings in the correct PE kit every week.
