We have had a great start to Year 6! This term we are learning about the Tudor Era – what it was like and the significances it had on society today.



We are also reading 'Pig Heart Boy' by Malorie Blackman in Guided Reading and are producing some amazing writing based on the story in our English lessons.

Art	Exploring Tudor style portraits Examining features of Tudor portraits Creating our own portraits in a Tudor style

History	We will be Exploring a timeline of Tudor history Analysing different sources from the Tudor Era Understanding why Henry VIII founded the Church of England Investigating perceptions of Henry VIII
Music	We will be Learning The Theory of Music (The Elements of Music, Traditional and graphic Music Notation) Learning how to play pieces on the Keyboard using all five fingers. Working in small groups, pairs and individually towards a final performance
P.E	We will be: Developing skills to play cricket Developing hand-eye co-ordination skills Learning how to catch and throw a cricket ball accurately Developing a sense of anticipation and quick reflexes
R.E *** ***	 We will be: Studying different religions views on 'Love and Marriage' Learning about Christian traditions of marriage and why it is important for Christians to be wed. Learning about Islamic traditions of marriage and the symbolic meanings of marriage in Islam.
P.S.H.E and Citizenship	We will be: Developing social and emotional health and self-care. Understanding the importance of mental health and how and where you can find support.

Here are some ways that you can help your child at home:

- Ensure they are using the independent learning folder on their iPad
- It is very important that you read with your child every night please remember to do so, just 10 minutes will help and don't forget to sign your child's reading record!
- Help your children with practising their conversions of metric units and with telling the time on both digital and analogue clocks by testing them frequently throughout the day.
- Practise your child's spelling to prepare them for their tests, remembering their handwriting joins.
- Encourage use of Spelling Shed and Maths Shed– free online education games daily.
- Remember to bring PE kits every **Friday**
- Ensuring that their homework is completed every week by Tuesday.
