The Enfield School Age Immunisation Team will be visiting Oasis Academy Hadley
On Wednesday 7th February 2024 to administer the Human Papillomavirus (HPV) and
Measles Mumps and Rubella (MMR) vaccinations, as scheduled in your child's **Red Book**

Human Papillomavirus (HPV)

HPV is a group of viruses which, when spread through sexual contact, can cause cancers, such as head and neck cancers, cervical cancer, anal cancer and genital cancers.

The vaccine is available to both boys and girls in Year 8.

Only 1 dose is needed to complete this vaccine course.

Measles Mumps and Rubella (MMR)

Your child may have already had this vaccination before they started primary school.

Any child who has *not had 2 doses* of MMR vaccine, please complete the MMR consent form.

Please check your Red Book before completing the MMR consent form

To complete a form to give consent **OR** to decline the vaccine, please follow the links below.
Please only complete the MMR vaccine form if your child needs it.

If we do not receive a consent form, we may contact you by telephone or email to obtain one from you.

If we have not received a consent form back by the time of school session, then we can ask your child for their consent. If your child can show that they fully understand what these vaccines are for and if they say that they want them, then we would class them as Gillick Competent and can give them the vaccine.

If you submit a **YES** consent on behalf of your child and they refuse vaccination, it will not be given.
