

# A level Turkish



## Entry requirements

In order to study this subject, you must have achieved at least grade 6 at GCSE level.

## Course Outline

There are four main themes; each theme has two sub-themes and one research project. Students must complete two compulsory tasks: they may either critically analyse two literary texts, or critically analyse one literary text and one film.

1. Society topics includes - Integration and exclusion, heritage, history etc.
2. The world around us - Travel, tourism, technology and environmental issues.
3. Education - Employment and unemployment
4. Custom - Traditions, beliefs and religions.

## Assessment Subject Information

**Turkish A level is linear course; this means all three papers will be sat in the same examination year (at the end of the course)**

Paper 1: Translation into English, reading comprehension and writing (research question) 80 Marks

Paper 2: Translation into the target language and written response to works (film and Novel) -110 Marks

Paper 3: Listening, reading and writing – 60 Marks

## Career Pathways

This course will be taken as a full A level (two years) leading to a university degree. Most universities including the Russel Group universities recognise Turkish A-Level and are willing to give students full UCAS points on successful completion of the course. Languages are highly versatile and complement most subjects.
