Dear Parent/Carer

**A reminder of our expectations of Learning and Behaviour**

At Oasis Academy Hadley we have high expectations of all our students. We want them to make good progress, achieve great outcomes and be happy at school.

We aim to ensure that every student has a good learning experience, which is underpinned by quality teaching, together with clear and fair rules regarding attendance, behaviour and conduct that enable them to enjoy learning and feel safe.

To this end, I think it is important to remind parents and carers about some of our expectations:

- All students are expected to come to the Academy every day on time with the main focus of learning. To secure safety and wellbeing, students should arrive on time to every lesson and should not leave the class without written permission from a teacher.
- To maintain a positive learning environment, students should conduct themselves in a polite and respectful manner when interacting with teachers and adminstaff. Disrespectful language, actions and rudeness will result in a serious sanction.
- We have an Academy uniform, which should be worn with pride at all times. Students are expected to arrive to the Academy smartly dressed in full academy uniform. This includes black polishable shoes and where trousers are worn they must be secured around the waist with a black belt if necessary but not worn low on the hips.
- A bag and stationery are essential learning tools. All students are expected to carry a pen, pencil, ruler, rubber and a calculator with them to school in their bag. To ensure this happens it is helpful for bags to be packed ready for school the night before with parents and carers checking this regularly.

Working in partnership with parents is something we value highly and so I would very much appreciate your support in discussing expectations with your child so that they can begin the 2020 Spring Term feeling confident, prepared and ready to learn.
