Growing -plants and caterpillars



<p>English</p> 	<p>We will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read stories relating to growth • Identify the initial, middle and final sounds in simple words. • Blend and segment sounds in words. • Read for enjoyment, in groups and as a class. • Write sentences using words with more than one syllable. • Writing stories independently.
<p>Mathematics</p> 	<p>We will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Count up to 20 or more objects reliably. • Recognise numbers to twenty • Order numbers to twenty and beyond. • Solve problems involving sharing objects between 2. • Compare two sets of objects. • Use language such as 'taller', 'shorter', 'heavier' or 'lighter' to compare quantities • Use mathematical language to describe in the environment

The children will continue to build their confidence through trying new activities and working in teams. In PE sessions, we will be experimenting with different ways of throwing and rolling a ball and playing hockey.

Here are some ways that you can help your child at home:

- Continue to read with your children every night, this is very important and helps your child learn. Please remember to sign your child's reading record every day.
- Help your child to read the key words every day.
- Please support your child to complete their homework and hand it in on time. Homework is always due on a Tuesday.
- Encourage your child to dress and undress by themselves.
- ***Ensure your child is at school every day on time by 8.50am to make outstanding progress***
